“Disciple” was a very common word that was used at the time of Christ and by those who followed Him. Today’s understanding of the term “disciple” dose not carry the same meaning as it did in Biblical times. All Biblical/Scripture teachers had disciples. It was common for a Rabbi to have several boys he taught and developed a relationship with them as the learned the Torah. It was this student Teacher relationship that developed them into disciples. A disciple was far more than one having an intellectual understanding of a particular belief system. The truth is we as Christians can never become a “Master Christian”. We are all lifelong learners.
